Measurement Report as of December 31, 2024

In early 2022, the Town of Oyster Bay (representing the hamlets of Glen Head and Glenwood Landing), the Villages of Sea Cliff, Old Brookville, Roslyn Harbor, and City of Glen Cove, presently served by Liberty Utilities, appointed six Board members to the Water Authority of North Shore. The objective of the Water Authority of North Shore is to negotiate for the acquisition of the private water supply system in the affected communities and to provide public drinking water with a local governmental not-for-profit water company.

Currently, the Board members have initiated and are progressing with discussions with Liberty Utilities to remove them as the community's water supplier and replace them with the Water Authority of North Shore. Our sole focus is to become a community public water company. This website and other social media venues will be used to provide you with information and updates on our goal's progress.
